Please be advised that the New Jersey Crime Victims' Law Center does hereby enter its appearance on behalf of the victims in the above referenced matter. As defined by the New Jersey Constitution, the term "victim" includes the survivors of a homicide victim.

A victim of crime has certain civil rights in these criminal proceedings pursuant to Article 1, paragraph 22 of the New Jersey Constitution, N.J.S.A. 52:4B-34, *et seq.*, the Crime Victims Bill of Rights, and such further statutory and case law authority in the State of New Jersey and under federal law. Included in these rights, the victim has the right to be notified of and be present at all judicial proceedings in this matter.

As legal counsel for the victim in the protection and advocacy of these rights, the New Jersey Crime Victims' Law center is entitled to receive all court notices sent to attorneys in this case.
