ORDER GRANTING PRELIMINARY
INJUNCTION AGAINST DEFENDANT
ROBERT VANAMAN,
DISMISSING PLAINTIFF'S
COMPLAINT AS TO DEFENDANTS
STATE FARM INSURANCE
COMPANIES AND
NANCY VANAMAN, AND DENYING
THE MOTION OF DYLAN VANAMAN
AND DEAN VANAMAN TO
INTERVENE AND TO HAVE
A GUARDIAN *AD LITEM* APPOINTED

THIS MATTER being brought before the Court by Pompelio, Foreman & Gray, L.L.C., (Richard D. Pompelio, Esq. appearing) attorneys for plaintiff, Karin Shaffer, in the presence of Oandasan & Cooper, P.C. (Cheryl L. Cooper, Esq. appearing) attorneys for potential intervenors, Dylan Vanaman and Dean Vanaman, and Cherierici, Cherierici & Smith (Julie C. Smith, Esq. appearing), attorneys for defendant, State Farm Insurance Companies, and the Court having reviewed all papers filed herein, the argument of counsel; and for good cause shown.

IT IS on this _____ day of June 2009 **ORDERED** as follows:

1. Defendant Robert Vanaman is hereby **PRELIMINARILY ENJOINED AND RESTRAINED** from converting, transferring, encumbering, dissipating and/or depleting the assets of the Estate of Barbara Vanaman, deceased, and any and all assets held jointly by defendant Robert Vanaman with Barbara Vanaman, pending further order of this Court.
2. Defendant Robert Vanaman is hereby **PRELIMINARILY ENJOINED AND RESTRAINED** from converting, transferring, encumbering, dissipating and/or depleting any assets owned by Robert Vanaman, including pensions, vehicles and other personal property, money and asset accounts, real estate and such other property of defendant Robert Vanaman, or any part of any asset to which he may be entitled, pending further order of this Court.
3. Plaintiff's request to dismiss the complaint against defendant, Nancy Vanaman based on her representation to the Court that she disclaims any rights to the proceeds of the life insurance policies payable on the death of Barbara Vanaman, is hereby **GRANTED**.
4. As a result of the Court's order requiring defendant State Farm Insurance Companies to deposit all proceeds of life insurance policies payable on the death of Barbara Vanaman with the Surrogate of Cumberland County, the complaint of plaintiff against defendant State Farm Insurance Companies is hereby **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
5. The cross motion of Oandasan & Cooper, P.C. for an order permitting Dylan Vanaman and Dean Vanaman to intervene in this matter and for the appointment of a guardian *ad litem* is hereby **DENIED**.

6. The application of plaintiff Karin Shaffer to be appointed administrator *ad prosequendum* of the Estate of Barbara Vanaman for the purpose of prosecuting this wrongful death action is hereby GRANTED.
